As members of the Cedarcrest High School Marching Band Program, you are given privileges as well as responsibilities. You are also given the opportunity to represent your school with the highest honor and pride.

You have the responsibility to show each community we encounter the ideals of what we represent. With this commitment comes responsibility. **YOU** are responsible for your behavior and appearance ON AND OFF the field. This includes classes, bus trips, football games and competitions; before, during and after each event.

This responsibility includes the careful handling of your band uniform and all of its parts. These are expensive pieces of equipment that are assigned to each of you for your use during the season. This uniform must be treated carefully just as you should care for your instrument. Failure to care for your uniform in the manner described to you may result in monetary fines to you for the repairs or replacement should loss or damage occur beyond reasonable wear.

## CEDARCREST HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM RULES

- Uniforms are the property of the Cedarcrest High School Music Department.
- Uniform must be requested by assigned number. See posted uniform list.
- Uniforms are **not to be taken home**, but will be returned to their assigned space in the closets in the music room after each use.
- Uniform will be properly hung up after each performance. Students will not be permitted to leave until uniforms are checked. The pants should be folded on the crease and hung on the hanger. Jacket should be hung over pants and zipped. Hats should be returned to their box.
- Band T-shirt **MUST** be worn under uniform.
- If hems need to be adjusted, or other alterations or repairs need to occur, then a drum major or the director must be notified. Students are **NOT** to alter or repair uniforms on their own (no duct tape, staples, etc.)
- Black socks must be worn. No ankle, golf, tennis or other short socks allowed.
- Shoes should be cleaned **AT HOME, BEFORE** each event.

- Hair MUST be worn tucked securely to fit under shakos always while in uniform.
- No perfume, make-up, or hairspray is to be used while wearing the jackets (the alcohol in these products will stain the fabric.)
- Eating while in uniform is not allowed; students may eat before and after performances.
- The only jewelry allowed to be worn while in uniform are stud earrings.
- FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE RULES WILL RESULT IN FINES AND COULD RESULT IN THE LOSS OF UNIFORM RENTAL PRIVILEGES!!
